About

Gen SEA Summit 2026 will host **350+ delegates** from 10+ countries — including ASEAN 1967 Fellows, and other Bridge-to-Venture and Bridge-to-Market participants, university partner delegations, and ecosystem invitees.

Gen SEA Summit Delegates 2026 is a competitive open application that selects an additional **50 outstanding students and recent graduates** to join this room.

Selection is based on a structured pre-screening process. Universities and faculties play a central role by nominating candidates. All applicants must complete the Gen SEA Bootcamp before final selection. The 50 selected join the wider delegate community for the full three-day Summit.

Who Should Apply

Students and recent graduates who are:

- Aged 18–30
- Currently enrolled in, or graduated within 5 years of, a Bachelor's or Master's program
- Motivated to understand how ventures are built and scaled in ASEAN; whether or not they have a startup of their own
- From any field of study, any country

What's Included

The Gen SEA Summit Delegate experience consists of two distinct components:

The Gen SEA Bootcamp is a real, paid product. It is offered commercially to professionals and corporate teams across ASEAN. Selected Delegates receive it as part of the program — not as a bonus, but as the foundational training that makes the Summit experience meaningful.

Scholarship Tiers

All 50 selected Delegates receive a scholarship covering all or part of the **USD 300 Delegate Pass**. The Gen SEA Bootcamp is provided at no cost to all pre-screened candidates regardless of final scholarship tier.

You apply once. The committee assigns the scholarship level during final selection based on application strength, Bootcamp performance, and university nomination ranking.

How Selection Works

Stage 1 — Application opens (open to all eligible students) Students apply directly through the open application form. No nomination required to apply.

Stage 2 — University & faculty nomination In parallel, universities and faculties submit their **ranked list of up to 10 nominated candidates** through a dedicated nomination form. Nominations can be submitted at any point before the deadline.

Nominated candidates are flagged in the system and prioritized in pre-screening.

Stage 3 — Pre-screening The organizing committee reviews all applications. Pre-screened candidates are invited to the Gen SEA Bootcamp at no cost.

Stage 4 — Gen SEA Bootcamp Pre-screened candidates complete the online Gen SEA Bootcamp. Bootcamp performance, alongside university nomination ranking, becomes the primary input for final selection.

Stage 5 — Final selection 50 Delegates are announced — assigned to Full, Merit, or Half scholarship levels.

About the Gen SEA Bootcamp

The Gen SEA Bootcamp is built on the **Global Venture Playbook (GVP)** — SEA Bridge's flagship venture curriculum, used to train founders across Bridge-to-Venture, Bridge-to-Market, and ASEAN 1967.

It is the same program professionals and corporate teams pay **USD 1,500** to enroll in.

For Gen SEA Summit Delegates, it is included at no cost. Not as a giveaway — as the foundation that makes the Summit experience meaningful. Students who complete the Bootcamp arrive at Khon Kaen ready to engage with sector deep-dives, partner roundtables, and showcase sessions at depth — and are positioned to convert that into real opportunities across the SEA Bridge ecosystem.

Bootcamp completion is required for final selection.

Note for Universities

For institutions that want to **guarantee** their students' representation at the Summit — independent of the competitive selection — the **Delegation Partnership** track is available (USD 1,550 – 4,650). Many institutions use both pathways: nominating students for the scholarship while also securing guaranteed seats through partnership.

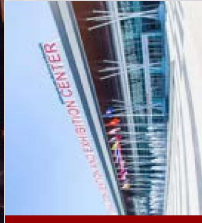
